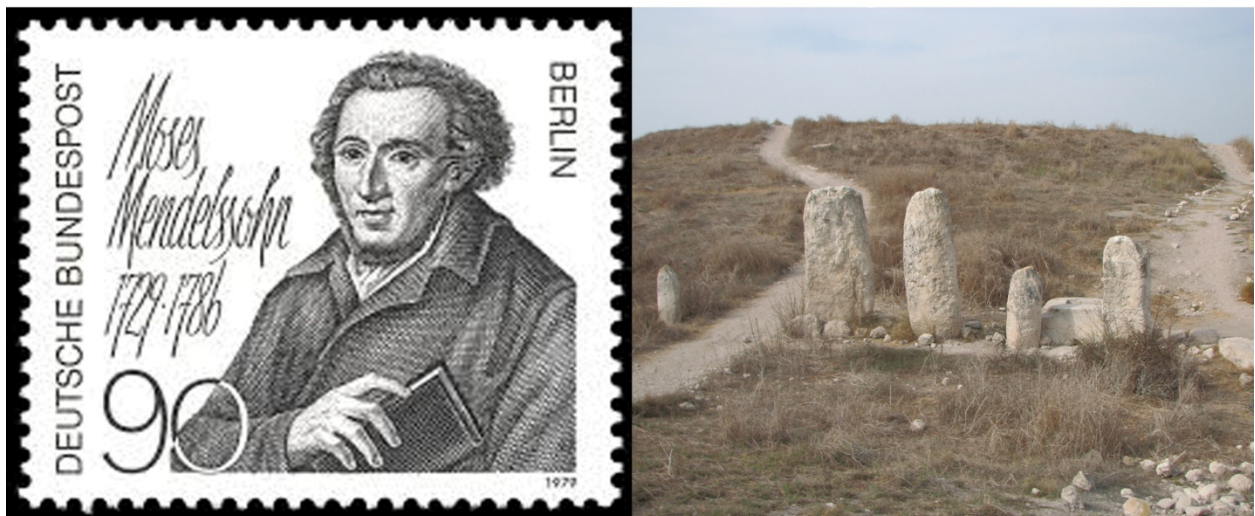

just outside the Reichstag

Sites of Jewish importance: Berlin Holocaust Memorial, Burning
of the Book Memorial

Jewish Museum (building designed by Daniel Libeskind). This is not a
Holocaust Museum—the permanent exhibition deals with the Jewish
contribution to life in Germany since the 1st century

Late afternoon time to either relax or enjoy shopping on Friedrichstrasse.

SS and Gestapo headquarters

Depart for the Mitte, Berlin’s Historic center district

Walking tour along Hamburger Strasse

Residential Monument and Moses Mendelssohn's grave

Museum Otto Weidt’s Workshop for the Blind: During the Second World War
the brush manufacturer and righteous gentile Otto Weidt employed
mainly blind and deaf Jews who produced brooms and brushes here, in
a futile effort to save them. Around this area we will also see small
markers in the sidewalk listing the names of people (mostly all Jews)
that lived in these buildings before the Holocaust

Rosenstrasse Memorial, site of peaceful protest by Aryan wives and
relatives of Jewish Germans rounded up for deportation

Tour Rykestrasse Synagogue, Germany's largest synagogue,
reopened 70 years after being damaged severely during Kristallnacht
Group Dinner with Rabbi Walter Hamolka of Geiger Rabbinical College

Wednesday, November 8

Visit Potsdam and cross the Glienicke Bridge, a famous exchange point
for Soviet spies

Visit Wannsee House, where a meeting to unveil the Final Solution
was infamously held

Palace of Sanssouci (brief photo stop)

Lunch (on own) nearby

Cecilienhof Palace, site of the Potsdam Conference

Return to Berlin

Stop at Gleis 17, train platform where Berlin's Jews were sent
to Polish concentration camps

Farewell dinner together
